- b) Outline 4 clinical indications uses of Praziquantel. (4 Marks)
- c) Antimalarial drugs are classified by their selective actions on the parasite's life cycle.

 Describe for classes of antimalarials and give specific examples in each case.(8 Marks)
- d) Explain 5 host factors to be considered in the selection an antibiotic. (5 Marks)
- e) (i) Trimethoprim-Sulfamethoxazole (Cotrimoxazole) combination is preferred over a single use of either of the drug. (2 Marks)
 - (ii) Outline 3 clinical uses of the combination in (i) above. (3 Marks)
- f) Discuss briefly transcutaneous route of drug administration. (4 Marks)

Question 2 (20 marks)
